Materials and Services

Below is a detail listing of the services required for this project.

- Clean up of all waste and discarded material shall be done at the close of each workday.
- The bidder will need to coordinate work with the Facilities and Maintenance Manager or his designee to allow for the maintenance shop to remain operational during the duration of the above project. SWT will accommodate the contractor to best of its ability as to not interfere with the reasonable progress of the work as described above.
- Warranty for materials and labor shall be no less than one year or as provided by manufacturer, which ever is greater, from completion date.
- Bid bonds are required.
